PARTICIPANT GUIDELINE

- Must be a Special Education Student.
- Sixteen (16) to twenty-one (21) years of age (16 and under can receive support services)
- Referral form completed by teacher
- Parent permission form signed and prompt completion of all necessary forms.
- <u>Satisfactory behavior, academic performance</u> and <u>attendance</u> record at school and in class.
- Demonstration of <u>mature behavior</u> and <u>positive attitude</u> toward employment.
- Willingness to participate in employment preparation sessions.
- Ability to get to a job site. (Transportation will not be provided by the district.)

The student will also be required to provide:\

- A valid Social Security card
- Some form of picture ID (Student Body card, California DMV ID or California drivers license)
- A completed Workability Application Form

Development of a transition plan as part of the IEP is an important component for successful referral to adult services for all SPECIAL EDUCATION students.
